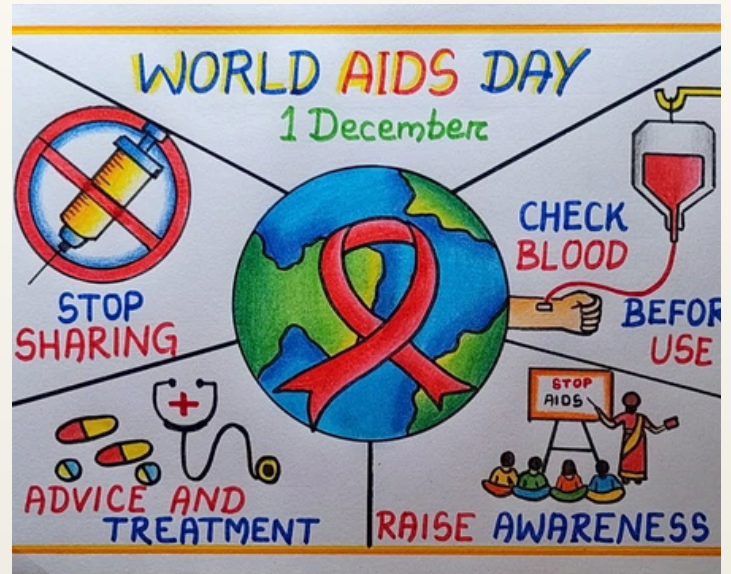

Olympiad examinations were successfully conducted to enhance students' logical thinking, subject knowledge, and competitive skills.

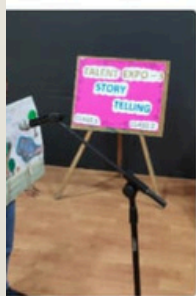


TALENT EXPO

The Talent Expo Inter-class competition was conducted to encourage creativity, confidence, and the overall talents of students.

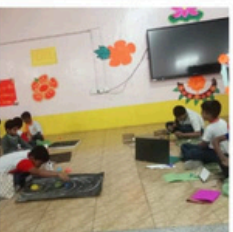
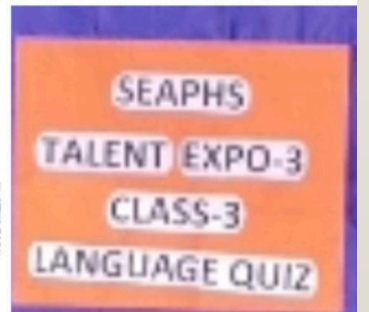


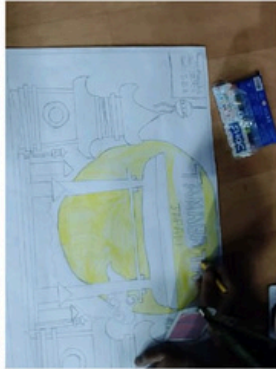
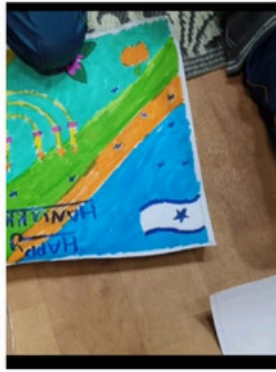
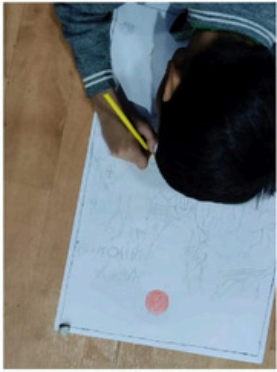
